



Course Description: Deploying LegaSuite GUI Applications

LegaSuite GUI allows you to implement a variety of end-user client types from a single development effort. Browser clients can be deployed to HTML, Java and Windows platforms. This course explores the various options.

Course Objectives

- Provide the necessary information to determine which deployment options are appropriate for particular environments.
- Facilitate successful deployment by transferring best practices knowledge of configuration, set-up options and other critical success factors.

Target Audience

This course is designated for system administrators responsible for deploying LegaSuite GUI applications to end users.

Prerequisites

Knowledge of Seagull Software file types, host application commands and navigation, and the target client environment operating system are required for this course.

Topics

- Developer kit concepts and development process
- How to use the Seagull Software Collector to gather data from an existing application
- Overview of change management
- Installing the Seagull Software Windows client and package files on a local PC
- Installing the Windows client and serving the package files to a PC via ActiveX from a NT or native server
- Using the native server or NT as a Web server to serve package files to a Java client accessed via a Web browser

Each of the above scenarios are explained with special attention to:

- File organization and placement
- Configurations for the LegaSuite GUI Server on various platforms
- How users launch LegaSuite GUI Clients across diverse
- How to set up SSL for various deployment scenarios
